

UPDATED: Sussex multi-agency procedures to support adults who self-neglect

Section 2.8. 'Sussex multi-agency procedures to support adults who self-neglect' of the Sussex Safeguarding Adults Policy and Procedures has been updated.

These procedures set out a framework for collaborative multi-agency working within Sussex to provide a clear pathway for all agencies to follow when working with adults who are self-neglecting. They are to assist professionals from any agency who are working with, and supporting, an adult who is displaying self-neglecting behaviours.

These procedures should be referenced whether or not the threshold for safeguarding has been met. Where the threshold for safeguarding is not met, staff may find it easier to refer to the standalone 'Sussex Self-Neglect Practice Guidance for Staff', which reflects key points from the full procedures.
